Directions to the Shareowner Meeting

FROM PHILADELPHIA ON I-95 SOUTH

- Take I-95 South through Chester to Wilmington.
- Follow I-95 South to Exit 7A marked "52 South, Delaware Ave."
 Follow exit road (11th Street) to intersection with Delaware Ave. marked "52 South, Business District."
- At the Delaware Ave. intersection, bear left, continuing on 11th Street. Follow 11th Street through four traffic lights. Hotel du Pont is on the right.

- Follow Route 202 to I-95 intersection. Take I-95 South. From I-95 South, follow steps 2-5 above.
